I am requesting your support for Macular Disease Foundation Australia's Federal Election 2016 key positions relating to the prevention of macular disease and the affordability and accessibility of treatment and rehabilitation. Key positions are:

1. Establishment of an equitable, national, federally funded low vision equipment program
2. Ensure the affordability of health care for the macular disease community
 - a) Immediately lift the indexation freeze on the Medicare Benefits Schedule
 - b) Private Health Insurance reform enabling payment of benefits for in-rooms treatment of macular disease
 - c) Medicare funding of OCT scans for management of macular diseases
3. Funding Macular Disease Foundation Australia for preventive health and chronic disease support

Macular disease is the leading cause of blindness and severe vision loss in Australia. The most prevalent form of the disease, macular degeneration, primarily affects older Australians. An estimated 1 in 7 Australians over 50 or 1.19 million people¹ have some evidence of macular degeneration.
